Poppy Project

Description:

The Museum is planning on installing a memorial tree in the vestibule of the Village of Nampa office. The tree will be decorated with poppies featuring the photo and name of veterans from Nampa and Northern Sunrise County. The tree will be left up for display the month of November.

Timeframe:

October; install to take place beginning of November.

Where tasks take place:

- Museum
- Your home

Time commitment:

Flexible – 1-2hrs per week minimum; depends on task taken

Volunteer tasks:

Volunteers may dedicate themselves to part or all of one or more of the following. All tasks can be done from at home or at the museum. The Museum Director will set deadlines for tasks to keep the project moving:

- Typing names of veterans from history book
- Preparing labels for poppies
- Cutting out poppies from red paper
- Pasting veteran photos onto poppies
- Preparing and installing the poppies on the tree (at the museum)

The Museum Director will be coordinating the project and is available to answer any questions as they arise.

If working from home, other than the typing of names, the volunteer will need to pick up and drop off tasks at the museum.

Required skills:

- Typing (if preparing the labels)
- Eye for detail (especially when cutting)
- Ability to handle tedious and repetitive tasks
- No computer skills necessary
